Why CBT?

- Improved Testing Environment
- Larger number of test locations
- Results Sooner
- Ultimately more frequent
- Greatly minimize security risks
- Uniformity of exam testing environment
- Better assessment of minimum competency
- More sophisticated / appropriate content



State CBT Exam Tips

• Bring:

- Valid Government Issued Identification
- Candidate Information Bulletin (CIB)
- Reference Materials
- Calculators
- Limit the Materials
 - Books
 - Calculators
 - Scales, protractors, etc.



State CBT Exam Tips

- Other Items You Might Bring:
 - Batteries, extra glasses, other loose items
 - Put in personal locker or leave in car
 - Your exam time will NOT be stopped to retrieve from locker or car!
- **DO NOT** bring:
 - Watch, clock, gloves, electronic devices
